

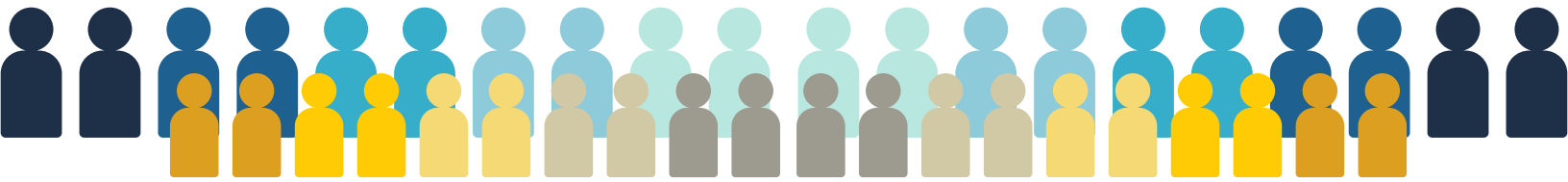
Did you know, an estimated... **2 Million** Americans have aphasia?
