

PHYSICIAN LETTER OF MEDICAL NECESSITY (SAMPLE)

Dear Physician,

- Letter of Medical Necessity

To assist you, an example of text one might include in a letter of Medical Necessity follows:

This individual needs to improve his/her communication skills as much as possible. Please accept this letter as a prescription for his/her participation in the intensive speech-language therapy program at the University Center for Language and Literacy.” Please add text stating reason the patient will benefit from intensive therapy.
